### Contributions to Social Networks and Public Media:

All contributions and announcements to SUTA social networks shall comply with the following guidelines:

- 1- Adhere to the bylaws available at <http://suta.org/bylaws>.
- 2- Use Only Farsi or English Language
- 3- Announcements shall be positive, constructive, SUT/SUTA-related, non-financially-oriented (fundraising or collecting money), non-religious, and non-political.
- 4- Any relevant contribution is welcome provided that they are constructive, professional, ethical and with no attacks, accusations, or improper language.
- 5- When you join the group, introduce yourself by name and your association with SUTA/SUT and use the following hashtags: #معرفی or #Intro
- 6- Keep messages clear, brief and concise.
- 7- If posting a link to online content (article, video, etc.), please make sure you have checked the contents. Also, include a brief description of the author and content of the link, if needed.
- 8- SUTA is not responsible for accuracy or content posted by individuals or groups and reserves the right to eliminate any/all posts that do not comply with these guidelines.
- 9- Greetings and Condolences should be only sent **privately** to the individuals to avoid cluttering the main page. Please inform one of the admins for public announcements on the main page!
